




Summer Flounder (Fluke)

3 fish at 18 inches


Open Season May 24 - Sept. 21



Bluefish (Snapper)

Fish are measured from tip of snout to tip of tail (except Black Sea Bass and Sharks). Cleaning or filleting of fish with a minimum size limit while at sea is prohibited.



Striped Bass or Hybrid Striped Bass

1 fish at 28 inches to less than 43 inches

1 fish 43 inches or greater

Delaware River & Tribs. - Upstream of Calhoun St. Bridge
Open Mar. 1 - Dec. 31
Trenton Calhoun St. Bridge to Salem River & Tribs.

Open Mar 1- Mar. 31 & June 1 - Dec. 31

(0-3 Miles from shore) No closed season


Atlantic Ocean (Greater than 3 miles from Shore) Closed all year


All other marine waters, open Mar. 1 - Dec. 31






Winter Flounder






KEEP OUR WATER CLEAN
